- Eligibility:**
- MSc and PhD students in the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Calgary
 - for international students, travel to home country for research purposes is not eligible
 - international research experience within a low or middle-income country
 - work involves underserved or vulnerable populations in international low or middle-income settings
 - funding not intended for presenting at or attending international conferences
 - minimum of 2-week visit
 - permission must be obtained from Graduate Supervisor and Associate Dean of Graduate Sciences Education
 - see page 2 of application form for information on travel clinic counseling, pre-departure briefing, registrations, and informed consent
