General Neurosurgery Locums in Calgary

The Section of Neurosurgery is inviting applications for Neurosurgeons, with an interest in doing 9-12 month locums.

Qualifications include an MD and a specialist certificate in Neurosurgery from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and eligibility for licensure in the Province of Alberta. You must be a Canadian citizen or hold Permanent Residency (PR) status in Canada. We are not able to consider anyone for locums without these qualifications.

The primary role for the locums will be to provide outstanding neurosurgical care to patients in the out-patient, in-patient, emergency and operating room setting. Teaching of post-graduate trainees and undergraduate students rotating on the neurosurgical service will be part of the responsibility. You will be expected to take on call as per the Section call schedule, and determined by the Section Head. Administrative support will be provided, as will a competitive remuneration contract for your services.

The Department of Clinical Neurosciences, Alberta Health Services and the University of Calgary are committed to employment equity.
