We are looking for people of all ages with **Parkinson's disease** or a **Parkinson Plus Syndrome**, as well as people 40 years of age or older without Parkinson's disease.

We want to understand how to improve the management and treatment of Parkinson's disease. ***Stepping forward to change lives.***

What would you have to do?

Attend 2 to 3 study visits lasting between 2 to 4 hours that would include:

- A questionnaire about your background and health
- An assessment of your mood, memory, and thinking
- A motor exam (Parkinson's participants only)
- A blood draw

The study visits will take place at the Foothills Hospital Campus. We will reimburse you for parking expenses.

In addition, there are 3 follow-up phone or online questionnaires at 18 month intervals.
