# Adult patients requiring a new, outpatient consultation with a neurologist within <u>5 BUSINESS DAYS</u> State why the referral is urgent. Fax: 403 270 1848

### **INCLUSION CRITERIA**

### NEW and/or progressive (over days or weeks; < 3 months)

Weakness (objective finding, focal)

Binocular visual changes (neurological: diplopia, homonymous hemianopia etc.)

Bulbar symptoms (dysarthria, dysphagia)

Aphasia

Worrisome headaches (with new neurological findings, thunderclap with normal investigations)

Focal neurological deficits

New neurological symptoms in a pregnant or immunocompromised person

#### NEW episode(s) of altered awareness or unexplained loss of consciousness (non-cardiac)

1<sup>st</sup> Seizure

Transient global amnesia

# **EXCLUSION CRITERIA**

Bell's palsy: if concern for stroke discuss with stroke team
Chronic neurological conditions

solated vertigo: see specialist clinical pathway

Monocular vision loss: <i>refer to ophthalmology</i>
Neurosurgical/ Spine/ Trauma related concerns (e.g. cauda equina, low back pain without deficits)
Pain without neurological deficit (including facial pain)
Subjective neurological symptoms
Syncope
Temporal arteritis: <i>refer to plastic surgery <u>and</u> internal medicine/rheumatology</i>
Transient Ischemic Attack: refer to Stroke Prevention Clinic
Need for neurological procedures: <i>Lumbar puncture is <u>not</u> available at urgent neurology clinic</i>
Patients who are:
<u>briefly</u> visiting from out of province
requiring admission
currently admitted
<ul> <li>seen in ER by neurologist service: attending neurologist to decide disposition and follow-up</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>under the care of a neurologist for <u>same issue</u></li> </ul>
<ul> <li>requesting medicolegal, WCB claims</li> </ul>
requesting second opinions
