- The pentad is OUT! Instead, consider TTP in patients with hemolytic anemia, thrombocytopenia & no identifiable cause
- The PLASMIC score (available on MD Calc) is a locally validated tool to help risk stratify which patients may need empiric plasma exchange (PLEX)
- The goal in suspected cases is to initiate PLEX within 4-8h. Delays occur due to failure to recognize the diagnosis and logistical challenges. Involve hematology early.
- Hematology is developing a pathway in the works to help navigate these challenging cases, stay tuned!
