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#### Psych care for family

The University of Calgary Psychology Clinic will be prioritizing providing psychological counselling services to the children and youth of frontline healthcare providers within AHS during the COVID-19 pandemic via

telepsychology. Children, youth, and adolescence (age 6 to 17 years) who are experiencing stress, anxiety, or worry related to the pandemic and the well-being of their parents or family members are eligible for this short-term service. For concerns related to children under the age of 6 years, parent consultations can be provided. This service will be provided free of charge, via secure tele-health, and provided by doctoral trainees under the supervision of a licensed psychologists. No referral is required.

#### **Diabetes Hotline**

<u>C-Endo has launched a province-wide Diabetes support line</u>. Our Certified Diabetes Educators will provide nutrition advice, general diabetes advice, and will send high risk patients to HealthLink / AHS endo emergency resources / or have one of our own specialists engage. This is a community service effort. There is no fee for this service. <u>https://albertadiabeteslink.ca/</u> is also an online resource for patients with Diabetes.

Rapid Access Addiction Medicine Program, also known as RAAM, provides quick evaluation for addiction concerns within an outpatient setting while providing an intervention, initiating treatment, and supporting recovery for both individuals accessing the program and the community as a whole. RAAM clinicians provide assessment and recommendations for treatment for clients with substance use issues. Most RAAM physicians are trained and certified addiction specialists that have the ability to prescribe medications that address substance use, cravings, and withdrawal, as well as provide complex psychosocial and medical interventions for clients including home detoxification. We accept referrals from all physicians in the community including the Emergency Departments. The RAAM is part of Adult Addiction Services Calgary, which for years has accepted walk-ins and accepted patients being sent from the ED. We are now adding RAAM and formalizing the process.
