#### **Update Regarding Open Shifts**

You will all have seen the newsletter and email posting of opportunities to work in Calgary Zone Urgent Care Centers and rural EDs across the province. We post these as a service to those organizations and communities as part of our desire to be good citizens in the medical community.

These outside organizations would agree however that it is incumbent upon each Department to consider their own shift obligations before taking on work in other zones or departments.

There are multiple open shifts due to ED MD medical illness in the Calgary Zone EDs as well as near-daily 10-plus hour waits to see an ED MD.

We would like to acknowledge that conditions are very difficult right now for both MDs and RNs in short staffed EDs. Efforts to resolve the staffing crisis are ongoing.

We appreciate the hard work and patience on shift and the ongoing efforts of the medical/RN leadership at each site to manage the crisis.

#### **ED Physicians:**

After serving for two successful years as the Connect Care Physician Builder Lead, Chris Hall has decided to step down effective August 31, 2022. Chris has done a very good job in this role. We would like to thank him for his work & contributions to make the Connect Care transition successful for the Calgary Zone Emergency Department. We are now in the process of recruiting a new Connect Care Physician Builder Lead.

#### About the Position:

The Connect Care Physician Builder Lead is considered a **0.1FTE** position, compensated at the rate of **\$23,199** annually. If you're interested in applying for this exceptional opportunity, please email me a cover letter highlighting your interest and skillset for this position, and an updated CV **on or before August 8, 2022.** 

The Connect Care & Physician Builder Lead promotes clinical improvement through hands on involvement during the Connect Care launches. This role trains for Epic Physician or Content Builder Certification and builds organizational capacity for CIS customization, optimization, content development, testing and analytics. Clinician Builders bridge clinical and technical domains by improving characterization of user needs while easing pathways to solutions. In short, Clinician Builders help organize the CIS user population, improve communication between the IT team and users, generate CIS content, and promote meaningful use of the CIS.

A key part of an effective clinician engagement strategy, clinician builders promote end-user organization, empowerment and accountability. Key to empowerment is building capacity to customize and shape the CIS to better address clinical, quality improvement, safety, and innovation and education goals. Connect Care & Physician Builders gain the understanding, tools and relationships needed to be effective change agents.

This role acts as liaison between departmental leadership and the Connect Care team / office of the Chief Medical Information Officer on issues related to Connect Care implementation; develops detailed understanding of the Epic / Connect Care platform as it related to ED operations; provides educational sessions to ED physicians prior to and around the time of Connect Care launch in Calgary if a need for such sessions (over and above the standard training sessions provided by the CMIO's office) is identified.

This position plays a lead role in the development and modification of order sets relevant to the ED and integration of evidence based decision support tools in the Connect Care order sets; prioritizes the implementation of Calgary specific customizations, develops site & zone-based level dashboards and other reporting tools relevant to the operational needs of the Department of Emergency Medicine.
