## **PAXLOVID Info for Calgary Zone**

Please see this memo from Alberta Health Services regarding Paxlovid use in the Calgary Zone.

Summary points:

- -oral med for treating COVID infection, contains nirmatrelvir and ritonavir
- -obtained free from selected pharmacies in the Calgary Zone
- -need to have positive PCR and be within 5 days of illness start

see eligibility criteria:

- Unvax + >65,
- Unvax + >18 with cormorbidities
- any vax and pregnant (if benefits outweigh risks)
- · any vax and immunocompromised

-ONLY prescribed by on call "Monoclonal antibody MD" accessed by patients thru healthlink – we won't be prescribing this yet.

#### CSM Dean - Search & Selection Update

As a result of the extensive work done by the CSM Advisory Decanal Selection Committee and Janet Soles & Associates Executive Search, we had a strong applicant pool for the position of Dean. The committee has identified three candidates for second-round interviews. During the townhall meetings there was discussion about the potential for an open versus closed process. We are indeed moving forward with an open process. This means that each of the three candidates that are coming back for a second interview will also make a public presentation. During their public presentation (virtual), each candidate will present followed by a question and answer session.

#### Opportunity: Clerkship Director - Emergency Medicine UME
