Operations

COVID Capacity Update

This is setting up to be a challenging wave with admissions rising quickly and a combination of factors conspiring to test our ED flow.

While ED visits are steady, Emergency Inpatients (EIPs) are rising due to reduced inpatient capacity (staff illness, bed closures for isolation) and increased inpatient demand (rapidly increasing admission rates and inability to discharge to continuing care facilities that are on outbreak).

This decreased ED "output" combined increased ED "Throughput" times (with our own inability to staff our departments fully with RNs/ MDs due to illness/COVID positive status) is making for prolonged ED waits.

EMS is seeing large increases in 911 calls and have been in "Red Alert" many times in the past few weeks with unacceptably high response times for calls. They have recently instituted triaging their lower acuity calls and are placing patients in a queue. Please work within your site protocols to prioritize patients in EMS park.

We appreciate everyone's flexibility in covering open shifts and keeping up to date with policy changes. (see today's newsletter for update on new PCR testing guidelines).

New Guidance for PCR Testing

A major change to PCR testing for COVID was announced yesterday by the Government Of Alberta. Please see here. Please note that the eligibility requirements for COVID PCR testing are now quite limited. Formal lab PCR testing is only required if it is going to change the patient's treatment (ie. Monoclonal Ab therapy) or if the person is being admitted or is part of a special community at risk. I would still recommend early testing for patients that might require admission. Please consider PCR testing for symptomatic pregnant patients and recall that the admission and follow-up criteria are different for this population.
