People occasionally reach out to me with questions about how plans are developed, the impact of the Connect Care transition, for advice for patients who are unhappy with their Treatment Plans etc. Please see these attached FAQs for some info you can use to support your care of Treatment Plan patients, and info for referring patients for plan development.

#### Building an ED Treatment Planning Hub - Funding Available

To bolster the sustainability of this committee, I would like to build a "hub" of MDs interested in authorship. To date, more than 28 ED physicians have authored plans, and some have authored several or many plans. ED Treatment Plans improve patient care and help our system, and the process is interesting and rewarding. We also have some funding available - see below. This contribution is so appreciated by the committee, the Dept of EM, and your colleagues!

If you are interested in being added to our Hub, please let me know via email. I anticipate emailing members of the hub every 1-2 months with authorship opportunities. Hub members would take priority for honorarium funding (see below). There is no obligation to attend committee meetings.

After serving for two successful years as the Associate Research Director, Katie Lin has decided to step down and focus on other things effective September 30, 2022. We would like to thank her for the many contributions to research within the Calgary Zone Emergency Department. We are now in the process of recruiting a new Associate Research Director.

**About the Position:** The Associate Research Director is considered a **0.2FTE** position and is paid from the University of Calgary. It is compensated at the rate of **\$41,790.50 annually** inclusive of vacation pay and there are no benefits associated with it. Innovation in emergency care and development of new evidence is critical to informing process and operational improvements, and in improving patient outcomes. - Developing original research ideas and leading in the performance and publication of these research ideas.

This role trains for Epic Physician or Content Builder Certification and builds organizational capacity for CIS customization, optimization, content development, testing and analytics. Clinician Builders bridge clinical and technical domains by improving characterization of user needs while easing pathways to solutions. In short, Clinician Builders help organize the CIS user population, improve communication between the IT team and users, generate CIS content, and promote meaningful use of the CIS.

A key part of an effective clinician engagement strategy, clinician builders promote end-user organization, empowerment and accountability. Key to empowerment is building capacity to customize and shape the CIS to better address clinical, quality improvement, safety, and innovation and education goals. Connect Care & Physician Builders gain the understanding, tools and relationships needed to be effective change agents.

This role acts as liaison between departmental leadership and the Connect Care team / office of the Chief Medical Information Officer on issues related to Connect Care implementation; develops detailed understanding of the Epic / Connect Care platform as it related to ED operations; provides educational sessions to ED physicians prior to and around the time of Connect Care launch in Calgary if a need for such sessions (over and above the standard training sessions provided by the CMIO's office) is identified.

We would like to thank Dr. Jen Nicol on her ground-breaking work & contribution as the Emergency Physician Liaison Lead for Mental Health these past 2 years.

The Department of Emergency Medicine (Alberta Health Services – Calgary Zone) is now accepting applications for a 0.1FTE (\$23, 199) [Emergency Physician Liaison Lead for Mental Health](#). This ½ day per week position is available immediately. This position is joint funded by the generosity of the Calgary Health Foundation and the Department of Psychiatry. The term for this position is one year renewable, with 3 years of funding expected to be in place.

The main focus of the EPLL – Mental Health will be to develop and educate emergency physicians on the best mental health practices in the Emergency Department, as well as after discharge. Seeking physicians to provide locum work in the Bonavista Peninsula Health Centre, Bonavista, NL during the summer and/or into the fall. The shifts are 24 hours or 48 hours based on physician preference and we are very flexible with dates so can generally work around availability. The work is to provide ER/on-call coverage (on-site during the day and off site at night and called as required). Critical escorts to another facility may also be required, as well as care of inpatients. A NP works in the inpatient unit weekdays. Clinic work can also be arranged for physicians that would like to do so.

Bonavista is a vibrant community that boasts some of the world's best vantage points for spotting puffins, icebergs and whales. It has numerous world class hiking trails and the Bonavista Peninsula has UNESCO designation for some of the best preserved fossils in the world. Bonavista attracts people worldwide because of its history, culture, unique restaurants, hiking trails, whale watching and ice bergs. If hired, you would be provided with nice family friendly accommodations at no cost. The rate of pay is currently \$3,088.86 for every 24 hours worked. Airline flights to and from Calgary and a vehicle rental are reimbursed, along with gas receipts and a meal allowance of \$43.70 daily. One travel day to NL and one travel day from NL is paid at \$825 for each day.

The Bonavista Peninsula Health Centre has 10 inpatient beds which includes one palliative care bed. The Protective Care Unit has 13 beds. The services include 24 hour emergency services, blood collection, laboratory services, diagnostic imaging, x-ray, diabetic education, dietician, chemotherapy services, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, phototherapy, mental health, outpatient clinics and inpatient services. The Centre is associated with the long term care facility Golden Heights Manor which consists of 70 beds (level 3 care) that includes one respite bed.
