Connect Care Update

Hello everyone,

Quick reminder this week about FAST pathway referrals (for urology, spinal surgery, and routine orthopedic referrals not going to cast clinic). It seems some ED physicians have been using the Edmonton FAST referral department when trying to access the Calgary FAST clinic. This is probably because the only internal FAST department is the one in Edmonton; the Calgary FAST clinic is still an external clinic, and so there will not be an internal referral department available from the dropdown list that directs the referral to Calgary.

Please remember that in order to refer to the Calgary FAST clinics, you must use the external referral process. Furthermore, the urology and spine clinics still have separate paper referral forms that should be available from the unit clerks. Details are available in the Calgary Zone referral workflows
