#### **Connect Care Update**

#### 1) @EDCOURSE@

There still seem to be a large number of docs who are not including the .edcourse smartphrase in their note template. If you have not been using this function, please consider adding it to your notes. The frustrating In Basket messages requesting our signatures for post-handover updates to the ED Course are now a thing of the past, making this a much less onerous request. Because critical information is often included in this section (Discharge plan, meds, etc) it is immensely useful to have it included in all your primary notes (even for many non-handover patients). Please consider including it in your primary note - downstream docs and pharmacists will thank you! (And for anyone working with residents - please encourage them to add EDCOURSE to their notes as well!)

#### 2) RAAPID Documentation

Similar to #1 - there still seem to be many docs not documenting their conversation with RAAPID on patients being sent into the ED. These notes can prove invaluable to the downstream EDMD to help clarify the reason for transfer and the preliminary plan of action. Even if the reason for transfer is straightforward, please try your best to include a brief note. If you've forgotten how to add RAAPID documentation, check out the ED Common Workflows document below. https://docs.google.com/document/d/11wPjhRV0wlj\_1jzAU9k35BFth2sq03Ip/edit?pli=1

#### 3) HPTP on Weekends

Don't forget that **PLC and SHC HPTP are not open on weekends**. If your patient is going to be seen on a weekend, you must refer them to either the RGH or FMC HPTP department. If you send the referral to one of the HPTP departments that is closed on the weekend, they may not check the referral queue until Monday and follow up will be delayed, which has led to some near misses.

#### 4) 'Ab-Lab' Pool Login Woes

If you are having difficulty logging in to the shared ED lab pool on your 'ab-lab' shift, please reach out to nurse clinician on shift to see if you can have your name added to the pool list. Please DO NOT just walk away from the 'ab-lab' list and leave it to the next doc, there could be very important labs requiring review in there (eg - positive blood cultures) and a delay in reviewing them could lead to adverse events. To any new hires: if you are uncertain if you have access to the pools, please let me know, and we can set you up.

#### 5) Refused outpatient referrals

If one of your outpatient referrals has been declined, please note that you can still enter a new referral to a different clinic even if the patient has left the department. Simply access the 'ED Chart' tab to search for the patient encounter, and once you have access to the patient's chart you can enter a new referral in the 'Dispo' tab in the usual fashion. NOTE - you CANNOT do this if you use the 'Patient Chart' item from the 'Epic' dropdown menu. You MUST use the 'ED Chart'
