

These groups manipulate victims into engaging in acts of self-harm, animal cruelty, and sexual

warning signs for parents and caregivers, including behavioral changes, unusual injuries, or association with extreme online content. It urges open communication, vigilance, and prompt reporting of concerns to protect youth from exploitation and radicalization.
