This week's Clinical Pharmacology and Toxicology pearl is on methylene blue.

Methylene blue is used in the management of patients with methemoglobinemia and distributive shock. It has also gained popularity in social media amongst people who take it daily for its alleged neuroprotective effects ("the blue tongue movement").
