

Triple-C Curriculum Requirements (2021-current)

Calgary Core Program

Year 1

The First Year of the Calgary Core Triple-C Curriculum is comprised of the following experiences, requirements, and courses:

Clinical Rotations – Family Medicine

1. Family Medicine with Behavioral Medicine and Mental Health (1 block)
2. Family Medicine with Addictions Plus Week (1 block)
3. Family Medicine with Care of the Child Plus Week (1 block)
4. Family Medicine Core (1 block)
5. Family Medicine Community (2 blocks)
6. Longitudinal Indigenous Health (during FM and/or Electives) (*optional learning experience*)
7. Longitudinal Long Term Care (during FM and /or Electives) (*optional learning experience*)

Clinical Rotations – Immersion Rotations

1. Adult Emergency Medicine (1 block)
2. Electives (1 block)
3. Internal Medicine (2 blocks)
4. Obstetrics/Low Risk Maternity (1 block)
5. Pediatrics (1 block)
6. Psychiatric Emergency Medicine (1 block)

Scholarship Requirements

1. Presentation of R1 PICO during EBM Academics
2. Satisfactory completion of the Quality Improvement Project

Mandatory Courses

Must be completed during the first year of the program

1. ACLS and BLS certification must be maintained throughout the entire Program
2. ALARM
3. NRP
4. ATLS (may be completed during the first year if advantageous for course availability and Resident R2 scheduling)

Mandatory Program Academic Sessions

Year 2

Clinical Rotations – Family Medicine

1. Family Medicine with Care of the Adult Plus Week (1 block)
2. Family Medicine Community (1 block)
 - Including after hours shifts
3. Family Medicine with Enriched Plus Week (1 block)
4. Family Medicine with Urgent Care (1 block)

Clinical Rotations - Immersion

1. Care of the Elderly (1 block)
2. Electives (2 blocks)
 - a. Electives MAY include selective experiences in Intensive Care, and/or Cardiac Care Unit
3. Hospitalist (1 block)
4. Low Risk Maternity (0.5 block - 2 weeks, 8 shifts)
5. Musculoskeletal (0.5 block - 2 weeks)
6. Pediatric Emergency Medicine (1 block)
7. Palliative Care (1 block)
8. Rural Family Medicine (2 blocks)

Scholarship Requirements

1. Successful completion of the Scholarship Project
2. Minimum 1 PICO presentation during an EBM Academics Seminar during the Program.

Mandatory Courses

In addition to Year 1 mandatory courses, the following must be completed prior to completion of the Program:

1. ACLS and BLS certification must be maintained throughout the entire Program
2. ATLS (if not completed in Year 1)
