Objective

Purpose

- opportunities for peer review of grants, grant applications, papers and other scholarly works
- access to information from the OHMES database regarding active members of OHMES and their research interests and expertise
- access to most OHMES events and services at no cost

Membership Responsibilities

Members will agree to:

- support and advance the vision and mission of OHMES
- provide a link to an online research profile, such as ResearchGate, an academic/departmental website, or PubMed
- have their name and affiliation disseminated publicly as part of OHMES
- have their name, affiliation, email address, and research interests made available to other OHMES members upon request
- report on their education scholarship activities, including research grants, abstracts, and publications

Membership Criteria & Term

OHMES accepts applications from faculty, residents, fellows, students and staff who are engaged in or are interested in health and medical education scholarship at the University of Calgary.

An affiliate membership is also available to those not affiliated with the University of Calgary.

Membership term is two years, and is automatically renewed unless the member submits an email request to the OHMES office to discontinue their OHMES membership.
