The Alberta Surgical Initiative (ASI) continues with the goal of having every Albertan receive their surgery within clinically recommended wait times by 2024. The Facilitated Access to Specialized Treatment (FAST) office (Central Intake for Ortho) was launched in the Calgary Zone on October 11, 2022. A special thank you to Dr. Peter Lewkonia for his assistance with this initiative. I would also like to thank all Section members that are participating and encourage all Section members to sign up.

The Chartered Surgical Facility (CSF) RFP process for Orthopaedics is proceeding. OR capacity for AHS funded procedures has been opened at Canada Surgery Solutions (Clearpoint Health) and a long-term contract is in the works. I would encourage all Section members to obtain privileges at the CSF as it will be an important component of OR allocation in the future. Health Human Resource continues to be a challenge as we attempt to gradually increase surgical volumes this fiscal year.

Acute care coverage continues to be a priority for the Section and Department. On a positive note, the Department of Surgery has established an Acute Care office and both CSA recruitment and a clinical ARP for extenders are proceeding. This remains the number one patient safety concern for the Section of Orthopaedics.

Connect Care is set to launch at FMC on November 6, 2022. Thank you to all Section members from PLC and ACH for your feedback, experience, and ongoing work with Connect Care in the previous launch (May 2022). This will undoubtedly help your fellow Section members.
