

We are currently recruiting child and young adult participants ages 11 to 25 and their parents for a study called Exploring social and adaptive functioning in people with rapid-onset functional tic-like behaviors. This study has been approved by the University of Calgary Conjoint Health Research Ethics Board (REB21-1351).

This study will examine the social and adaptive functioning, quality of life, mental health, social media use, and impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on patients with functional tic-like behaviours.



This study will ask participants to complete an online questionnaire that will take 60 to 90 minutes of your time. Participants will also be asked to attend an online clinical interview conducted over ZOOM that will take 30 to 50 minutes to complete. Parents of participants will also be asked to complete a questionnaire about their family, stress, and how the COVID-19 pandemic has affected them that will take 20 minutes to complete. Eligible participants will receive a \$50 e-gift card from their choice of Amazon, The Bay, Walmart, or Sephora for their participation.
