

MDSC 501 Graduate Assistant - Teaching (GAT) Position – Fall 2025
Bachelor of Health Sciences Program, Cumming School of Medicine

A half-time GAT position is available for **MDSC / BIOL 501 – Principles and mechanisms of Pharmacology**. This undergraduate course introduces the basic principles of pharmacology and explores the application of pharmacology in the context of clinical treatment.

The successful applicant will be mature, responsible, reliable, and able to meet deadlines. The candidate is preferably in their second year or higher of their masters or PhD program, and preferably with a specialization in pharmacology, physiology, molecular biology or biochemistry and have an enthusiasm / interest in the subject.

The role of the TA will be to support course coordinators Dr. Justin Deniset and Dr. Donna Slater with the following duties:

- attend in-class lectures (held Monday and Wednesday 5:00 - 6:15pm)
- general communication with course coordinators, guest lecturers and students
- managing submissions of assignments
- assist with grading course assignments in a timely manner
