MDSC 535 Graduate Assistant - Teaching (GAT) Position - Fall 2025

A half-time/one-full GAT position is available for MDSC 535 – Psychosocial Oncology. This undergraduate course provides a higher level introduction to psychosocial oncology taught in a seminar fashion by clinical and academic experts in the domain. Because of the more complex and varied nature of the material preference is given to higher achieving undergraduate students who are in the last year of their study program and who also have some research experience via Honors work, research courses, or volunteer or paid experience as research assistants. The course is paired with MDSC 635, which is opened to graduate students. All evaluations including mid-term(s), term paper, final assignment, are in written form, and good communication skills for discussions and writing are highly valued.

The successful applicant will be mature, responsible, reliable, and able to meet deadlines. The candidate is preferably in their second year or higher of their masters or PhD program, preferably with a specialization in health psychology or health sciences.

This position requires a graduate student with excellent writing skills (a writing sample may be requested) and the ability to provide constructive feedback on student essays. Outstanding organizational, verbal, and written skills are essential for success in this position. Experience with delivering online courses and/or the associated technologies is preferred.

This role supports Dr. Fiona Schulte in the following duties:

- grading course papers in a timely manner
- managing submissions of assignments
- managing and facilitating student questions during lectures
