

**HSOC 311 Graduate Assistant - Teaching (GAT) Position – Winter 2025**  
Bachelor of Health Sciences Program, Cumming School of Medicine

A full GAT position (204 hours) is available for **HSOC 311 – Health Services and Health Systems**. This undergraduate course provides an overview of the Canadian health care system, including historical underpinnings, current challenges, approaches to program and policy change, and international comparisons.

The successful applicant will be mature, responsible, reliable, and able to meet deadlines. The candidate is preferably in their second year or higher of their masters or PhD program, preferably with a demonstrated interest in health policy.

This position requires a graduate student with excellent writing skills (a writing sample may be requested) and the ability to provide constructive feedback on student work, including social media posts, critical reflections and written assignments. Outstanding organizational, verbal, and written skills are essential for success in this position. Preference will be given to applicants with health systems or policy experience from research, clinical, or government backgrounds, including experience with policy writing (e.g., op-eds, issue briefs).

- Attending class session on Wednesdays between 3-5:45pm
- Grading course work in a timely manner
- Managing submissions of assignments
- Providing input on course content and assessment strategies
- Managing and facilitating student questions during lectures and outside of class
- General course management
- Opportunity to guest lecture
