(mid-November to early December 2025, and late March to mid-April 2026)*

Applications are invited from graduate students for two half-time Graduate Assistant (Teaching) ("GAT") position for MDSC 308 - Interdisciplinary Research Approaches. Within that course, the Research Ethics module in the Bachelor of Health Sciences program offers an introduction to scientific integrity and clinical research ethics to second year undergraduates.

Successful applicants will be mature, responsible, reliable, able to meet deadlines, and preferably in the second year or beyond of a Master's or PhD program, with a strong knowledge of ethics and demonstrated ability to write well. Students with a strong background in social science, law or philosophy will also be considered.

This position requires a graduate student with excellent writing skills (a writing sample is requested) and the ability to provide constructive comments on student essays.

This role supports Dr. J. Guichon in the grading of the Research Ethics exam and paper in MDSC 308 and assists with facilitating the delivery of course content, including

- Attending lectures
- Facilitating student questions during lectures
- Conducting seminars of 20 students
- Managing submissions of assignments
- Ensuring fair and consistent marking
- Meeting the 21-day marking deadline
- Meeting with students about grades
