The Cumming School of Medicine in conjunction with the Alberta Children's Hospital Research Institute, invite internal applicants at the Associate Professor level (PhD, MD, or MD/PhD) with a research interest in pediatric hematology, experience establishing and leading successful research programs and teams, to serve as the holder of the *Barb Ibbotson Chair in Pediatric Hematology*.

The successful applicant will have recognized academic expertise in the development and implementation of pediatric hematology and immunology research. Demonstrated excellence in multidisciplinary and collaborative research in paediatric hematologic diseases along with proven educational leadership, will be an asset. The Chair is supported with annual allocations from an endowment held at the Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation.

The responsibilities of the Chair will include but are not limited to:

- a) Build an identifiable program of basic science, translational and /or clinical research that closely aligns with the clinical focus while building linkages with other health service disciplines and resources within the University of Calgary and Alberta Health Services;
- b) Developing and maintaining a world-class program oriented towards identifiable outcomes in basic science, translational, and/or clinical research;
- c) Creation of new knowledge but also imparting it through education and ensuring that it is transferred into the patient care setting in the form of new or revised clinical pathways/guidelines that identify best practices and improve individual patient outcomes and the health of the children of Alberta;
- d) Establishing effective education links with community stakeholders
- e) Attracting to the University outstanding students, fellows, research associates and faculty interested in pediatric hematology and immunology;
- f) Serve as a leader to attracting resources and expanding the research program.

The successful candidate will be an internationally recognized scientist and educator. The interests of the successful candidates should align strongly with the Child Health and Wellness strategic research priorities of the Alberta Children's Hospital Research Institute and the Cumming School of Medicine's strategic plan.
