The Cumming School of Medicine in conjunction with the Alberta Children's Hospital Research Institute, invite internal applicants at the Associate Professor or full Professor level (PhD, MD, or MD/PhD) to lead and conduct health services outcomes research as the *Dr. Robert Haslam Chair in Pediatric Neurology*.

The successful applicant will have demonstrated excellence and leadership in child neurology, research and medical education. An academic interest in seizure disorders, neurological disorders of the premature infant, neurodevelopmental disorders, including genetic and chemical neurological disorders, will be an asset. The Chair is supported with annual allocations from an endowment held at the Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation.

The responsibilities of the Chair will include but are not limited to:

- a) Providing leadership in the development and implementation of child neurology;
- b) Developing and maintaining a world-class program oriented towards child neurology;
- c) Promoting collaborative research across disciplines, building on strengths and utilizing the existing resources available in the University of Calgary Cumming School of Medicine;
- d) Building an identifiable program of clinical care, education and research in child neurology while developing linkages with other health service disciplines, and resources within the University of Calgary and Alberta Health Services;
- e) Establishing effective education links with community groups that have an interest in pediatric neurodevelopment; and
- f) Attracting to the University outstanding students, research associates and Faculty.
- g) Serve as a leader to attracting resources and expanding the research program.

The successful candidate will be an internationally recognized scientist and educator. The interests of the successful candidates should align strongly with the strategic research priorities of the Alberta Children's Hospital Research Institute and the Cumming School of Medicine's strategic plan.

Applications must be submitted by September 15, 2020 as a single PDF by email. Application should include:

- Cover letter and curriculum vitae
- Strategic plan for the 5-year term of the Chair
