Purpose: To assist in developing and providing leadership in basic and/ or clinical research in the area of hearing deficiency by:

- Providing leadership in research in hearing deficiencies
- Promoting collaborative research across disciplines, building on strength and utilizing the existing resources currently available in the CSM and UofC
- Promoting service and educational programs in relation to hearing deficiencies and fostering a bench-to-bedside approach to research in hearing deficiencies

Applicant eligibility: The competition is open to all investigators with a Full-time appointment at University of Calgary at the time of the application deadline.

Application team can be an individual or teams, especially for the larger award.

Value for larger award: up to \$100,000 - one award available

Value for smaller award: up to \$50,000 - two awards available


Term of award: up to 3 years - contingent upon committee review at the 2nd year, availability of funds (funding provided annually at the approved level) and application to Tri-Council funding agency within 24 months

Responsibility of recipients:

- Growing productivity
- Application to a Tri-Council funding agency based on the pilot data gathered through this award
- Successful candidate submits a project progress report for committee review at the 2-year mark at a research session with all the project holders presenting their data; if progress is satisfactory, the committee will approve 3rd year of funding
 - The committee may review progress (or a progress report) after 1-year; for smaller projects, the committee may use the progress report to decide on funding for the upcoming year; expectation to participate in the research session at the 2-year mark


1. Description of project (maximum 200-250 words)

Provide a statement that highlights the relevance to the area of hearing deficiency. Use language suitable for non-scientists as this summary may be shared with public stakeholders.


2. Research Proposal (maxim 2 pages, font size no smaller than 11)
