

The Meredith Campbell Helgeson Research Award

in Colon Cancer and Surgical Oncology Endowment

Guidelines and Eligibility

PURPOSE: To support research in the areas of either colon cancer or surgical oncology.

AWARD VALUE: up to \$11,100 **DEADLINE**: October 28, 2024

DURATION of AWARD: One year

ALLOWABLE EXPENDITURE:

- Salary support support for graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, trainees and, if appropriate, faculty salary support to expand capacity in either colon cancer or surgical oncology
- Research support for research projects related to either colon cancer or surgical oncology. This includes consumables, travel, equipment, and other relevant costs
- Travel to support conference travel
- Other reasonable expenses as approved by the Standing Committee

CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY: The award competition is open to researchers with a primary appointment within the Cumming School of Medicine.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- Evidence of commitment to research in the area of either colon cancer or surgical oncology
- Quality of candidate: academic excellence, research experience, awards
- Significance and quality of the proposed project

REPORTING: The recipient of award from the Meredith Campbell Helgeson Research Award in Colon Cancer and Surgical Oncology Endowment will be providing reporting on the use of funds up on request from the Standing Committee at the Arnie Charbonneau Cancer Institute at: charbonneau@ucalgary.ca and/or Development and Alumni Engagement Office.
