

### Meet Dr. Elijah Dixon!

Dr. Dixon is a Professor of Surgery, Oncology and Community Health Sciences with the University of Calgary. He is a practicing General Surgeon at Foothills Hospital with a focus in Hepatobiliary/Pancreatic Surgery. Dr. Dixon completed his Undergrad in General Science and Medical School at the University of Manitoba, and then Surgical Residency at the University of

Calgary. From there he went to the University of Toronto and did a Fellowship in Hepatobiliary/Pancreatic Surgery and GI Transplantation at the Toronto General Hospital. He then proceeded to the Harvard School of Public Health and did a Masters in Epidemiology. In 2004 he returned to the University of Calgary, and in June of 2014 embarked on his new adventure as the Section Chief of General Surgery.

Dr. Dixon was drawn to the field of surgery early on in Medical School. He finds it to be both interesting and challenging. He especially likes to perform complex surgeries which drew him to the area of oncology. Through his research he is working on identifying improved outcomes for cancer patients.

Dr. Dixon's research interests include the development of quality indicators of care for patients undergoing hepatic resection for metastatic colorectal cancer. He conducts clinical research, particularly in the area of hepato-pancreatico-biliary surgery.
