NSERC - Collaborative Research and Training Experience (CREATE) - 2021 iNOI Now Open

CREATE Overview

The NSERC CREATE program **supports the training of highly qualified students and postdoctoral fellows** from Canada and abroad through the development of innovative training programs. Successful applicants will consist of a group of accomplished researchers (at least 70% of the group must be from NSE) who will work collaboratively to offer enriched training and mentoring experience for primarily graduate (master's and doctoral) students through new training initiatives. A researcher may only be the applicant on one CREATE proposal, and may not be on more than two proposals as either applicant or co-applicant, in any year.

Award Amount & Duration: up to \$1.65M, over 6 years

Internal Notice of Intent (NOI) Process and Deadline

A yearly quota has been established for each university, and only those researchers selected at their university can submit to NSERC. As a result, you must **submit an internal NOI to the OADR by January 8, 2021** -- i.e. [download the \(5pg\) iNOI form here](#) and submit the completed form to [Paul Daniels](#) by then. (No RFAA or RMS record is required at this stage.)

RSO is offering an optional 'Test Your Concept' session on 19 Oct 2020; you are encouraged to participate if this is your first time submitting to the CREATE program. **To register for this, contact RSO by 9 Oct 2020.**
