REPORTING and ANALYTICS AHS Data & Analytics (DnA) – new data and analytics literacy tools!

AHS DnA recently developed two on-demand, quick and easy-to-use, tools to improve data/analytics literacy. These tools provide excellent ways to develop your data skills at your own pace. Each starts with a short self-assessment which then generates a customized list of learning resources based on your responses. Separate tools are available for:

- Everyday Data Users aimed at clinicians, managers and front-line staff who use data to inform their decisions
- 2. Data Analysts aimed at the analysts on your team

Everyday Data Users: At all levels of AHS, our people use data, expertise, evidence and experience to inform decisions and improve outcomes for patients, populations and the health system. <u>This selfdirected data literacy tool</u> will help everyday users feel comfortable accessing and understanding data to improve the quality and efficiency of care throughout AHS.

RESEARCH – Recent Results from Connect Care Launch 4: At a Glance

• Connect Care Launch 4 successfully occurred on May 28/22. The research community has done a phenomenal job with submitting tickets, connecting with the Connect Care Support Team for Research, and supporting one another as part of such a large launch!

Congratulations to everyone; each and every individual who contributed to the success of this recent launch!

Launch 4 Ticketing Results as of June 21/22, at 1400h

86 tickets in total have been logged:

- 68 Tickets are closed and/or resolved
- 8 Tickets are in progress
- 8 Tickets on hold related to response time back from the end user
- 2 Tickets were canceled did not require any further investigation as a solution was determined

From the categorizes list in the table below regarding types of calls received, this included concerns or issues pertaining to user access, workflow and training issues, printing concerns, and configuration.

REPORTING and ANALYTICS: AHS Data & Analytics (DnA) - new data and analytics literacy tools! Cont'd...,

Data Analysts: A separate tool is designed for data analysts to help chart your professional development path: <u>Data</u> and <u>Analytics Professional Development Self-assessment Tool</u>

Questionnaire results auto-generate a list of learner resources and online courses that will increase your knowledge and skills in domains of interest. Information from your self-assessment can be incorporated into professional development planning discussions with your supervisor. Supervisors will be able to access their team members' recommended development resources via Tableau.

REPORTING: Frequently Asked Question

Why is my Reporting Workbench report not respecting the column order I have saved in the Report Settings? Since the Connect Care upgrade on April 14th some users have experienced difficulty in Reporting Workbench Reports respecting the column order in Report Settings.

This issue will occur when the user is looking at their Saved View of the report. To determine which view is showing for the results look to the top right corner of the results viewer. Follow these <u>steps and screenshots</u> to help resolve this issue.
