Note: You can also apply directly to the master's degree and complete it part-time, over three years, however, you would not be eligible for the graduate certificate or graduate diploma parchments. The advantage of applying directly to the master's program in your first year is, if you already know that you want to complete the master's degree, you won't need to apply to each program separately, as well as apply to graduate from each credential.
