- 3.Lead the Office of Surgical Quality in the Department of Surgery which can serve as a liaison between the sections, the hospital executive staff, the Provincial QI team and medical staff administration.
- 4. Organize and chair the Department of Surgery Quality Council Committee meetings.
- 5.Assist in coordinating quality initiatives in the Department of Surgery and collaborate with NSQIP initiatives.
- 6. Support the section QI and Safety.
