



## Orthopedic Trauma Surgeon Foothills Medical Centre

The Department of Surgery, Alberta Health Services – Calgary Zone and the University of Calgary, Section of Orthopaedic Surgery invite applications for an Orthopaedic Trauma and Upper Extremity (shoulder and elbow) Reconstructive Surgeon to work at the Foothills Medical Centre. Qualifications include an MD, certification by The Royal College of Surgeons of Canada in Orthopedic surgery and a postgraduate Master's/PhD degree. Fellowship training in Orthopaedic Trauma and Upper Extremity Reconstruction (Shoulder and Elbow) is required. Eligibility for licensure in the Province of Alberta is required.

The successful candidate will join the Foothills Medical Centre Orthopaedic Surgery group and participate in an Orthopaedic call schedule. Clinic support and elective surgical resources will reside at the Foothills Medical Centre with the option of privileges at additional chartered surgical facilities.

The successful candidate will act as a preceptor for learners at all levels of undergraduate and postgraduate medical education and will be expected to apply for a clinical academic appointment with The Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary.

The successful candidate must have significant experience and interest in clinical or basic research and will be expected to participate in the recruitment of subjects to ongoing research studies and collaborate in the initiation of new studies. The successful candidate will be expected to supervise medical students, residents and fellows in their research efforts.

Administrative roles within the Section of Orthopaedic Surgery will be mandated. The successful candidate will embrace a collaborative model to advance patient care and quality improvement.

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.
