

OPHTHALMOLOGIST - Medical and Surgical Retina Specialist (Locum)

The Department of Surgery, Alberta Health Services - Calgary Zone, and the University of Calgary, is seeking a locum for a Medical and Surgical Retina position. The successful applicant will provide clinic service within two multispecialty group practices, which include other retina specialists who can provide mentorship if needed. The locum includes 1-2 OR days per month, and 1:6 retina on call coverage. Start date ideally would be May 1st, 2025, but new graduates finishing their training at the end of June 2025 are also invited to apply and could start July 2025.

Qualifications:

Requirements include an MD, fellowship with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Ophthalmology or an FRCSC equivalent, and retina fellowship training in medical and surgical retina (1 year minimum, 2 years preferred). The ability to contribute to services including uveitis, ocular oncology, and/or retinopathy of prematurity screening are not mandatory but would be considered assets. Applicants must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta. The candidate must read, write and speak English.

In accordance with Canadian Immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. Please submit a letter of interest, Curriculum vitae, and three (3) letters of reference in PDF form to:
