



Pediatric Ophthalmologist

The Department of Surgery, Alberta Health Services – Calgary Zone and the University of Calgary invite applications for a dual certified Pediatric Ophthalmologist and Pediatric Neuro-ophthalmologist at the Alberta Children's Hospital in Calgary, Alberta. Required qualification include a MD, certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Ophthalmology, or equivalent. The candidate must have a minimum of one year fellowship training in Pediatric Ophthalmology and a formal fellowship in neuro-ophthalmology. Applicants must be eligible for licensure in the province of Alberta. This position is considered sponsorship eligible by Alberta Health Services.

The successful candidate will be expected to have a clinical appointment with the University of Calgary, Cumming School of Medicine, Department of Surgery. The successful candidate is expected to participate in medical student, resident and fellowship teaching, including direct clinical and surgical teaching and didactic lectures. Prior involvement in educational leadership is a requirement. The successful candidate would be expected to help lead the pediatric ophthalmology section as such evidence of administrative leadership would be an asset. A full pediatric ophthalmology clinic service will be provided on site at Alberta Children's Hospital. The candidate will be expected to participate in retinopathy of prematurity screening of neonates at all NICUs across the city. In addition, the successful candidate will have to contribute to call obligation in accordance with the section of Ophthalmology. There is the expectation to have academic output in the form of research, education and administration.

The successful candidate will become a member of the Section of Ophthalmology and the Section of Pediatric Surgery.

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. Deadline for application is October 1st. Please submit a letter of interest, letter of eligibility from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA), curriculum vitae and three letters of reference in PDF form to:
