QUALIFICATIONS

This leadership position is open only to surgeons who are or will be actively working / privileged at the Alberta Children's Hospital (ACH) in Pediatric General Surgery within the posted term.

OVERVIEW AND REPORTING

This position will provide administrative leadership of the Pediatric Surgical Trauma Program at the Alberta Children's Hospital, reporting to the Division Lead of Pediatric General Surgery and the Pediatric Surgery Site Chief.

The Pediatric Surgical Trauma Lead will work closely with the Medical Director of Pediatric Trauma and the Pediatric Trauma Coordinator at the Alberta Children's Hospital.

The Pediatric Surgical Trauma Lead will be expected to provide leadership and/or manage the following areas of the pediatric trauma program:

- Maintain, revise and expand the pediatric trauma service as required, including attention to quality improvement and quality assurance
- Resolve issues arising on the inpatient trauma unit related to patient care.
- Provide administrative/leadership coverage for the ACH Pediatric Trauma program when the Medical director is unavailable.
- Participate in preparations for accreditation of the pediatric trauma service as required
- Review and revise admission criteria for the inpatient service as required.
- Identify and plan for capacity issues.
- Develop evidence informed multidisciplinary protocols and guidelines for the care of the multiple/severely injured pediatric patient.
- Contribute to education programming as it relates to pediatric trauma including but not limited to ACH trauma rounds, multi-disciplinary and inter-professional hospital in-services, simulation activities and community outreach

The Pediatric Surgical Trauma Lead will represent the Section of Pediatric Surgery and the Department of Surgery on the following committees:

- The ACH Trauma Committee,
- The ACH Trauma Quality Management Committee.
- Ad hoc committees or working groups as needed.
- The ACH OR committee
