Drs. Claire Barber and Trafford Crump with the Department of Community Health Sciences are looking for a master's student to support research into the psychosocial complexity of patients diagnosed with rheumatoid arthritis with the ultimate goal of informing new care delivery models.

The student's research will focus on the psychometric evaluation and development of patient-reported survey instruments intended for use by patients diagnosed with rheumatoid arthritis. A relevant undergraduate degree with exposure to classical test theory and/or item response theory is required. Careful attention to detail and strong communication skills (both written and verbal) is required. Demonstrable knowledge of STATA, R, or SPSS is expected. Experience in a clinical research environment would be helpful.
