



CIHR – Canada Graduate Scholarships Master's Award 2015-2016 Frederick Banting and Charles Best Canada

Intended to provide special recognition and support to students who are pursuing a Master's degree in a health related field at a Canadian institution. These candidates are expected to have an exceptionally high potential for future research achievement and productivity.

- The total amount available for this funding opportunity is \$7M, enough to fund approximately 400 awards.
- Trainee stipend: \$17,500 per annum.
