Location	Organization	Details
International	Oracle Health Foundation	A grant for children with medical needs that can be used for therapy: maximum of 26 weekly sessions or maximum of 3 weeks of intensive therapy. <i>This grant is income dependent.</i>
Canada	Hope for Cerebral Palsy	Sponsorship for privately funded, 5 day intensives specifically for children under 5 years old.
Canada	SMILE Canada Support Services	Assists families with costs associated with a child and/or youth's disability, such as therapy. <i>This grant is income dependent.</i>
Canada	Jordan's Principle	Jordan's Principle is a child-first principle to ensure First Nations children get the services they need when they need them.
Canada	Cerebral Palsy Support Canada Project	A grant for \$1000 for children with Cerebral Palsy living in Canada.
Canada	March of Dimes	Free one-on-one Occupational Therapy consultations.
Ontario	Noah's Clubhouse	Funding in the amount of \$700 to use for therapy only.
Ontario	Jennifer Ashleigh Children's Charity	A grant for children who are in-patient or receiving receiving intensive outpatient treatment. This grant is income dependent.
