



The Department of Surgery, Alberta Health Services-Calgary Zone and the University of Calgary invite applications for the following position in the Section of Ophthalmology:

Ophthalmologist - Vitreoretinal Surgical and Medical Specialist

Qualifications include MD, a fellowship in the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada in Ophthalmology, and a minimum two-year medical and surgical vitreo-retinal fellowship. Applicants must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta. Competency with retinopathy of prematurity (ROP) screening and treatment is also required.

The successful candidate will be a member of the Section of Ophthalmology, Department of Surgery. There will be access to operating time at the Rockyview General Hospital as well as access to chartered surgical facilities for scheduled procedures. The successful candidate will be required to participate in the retina on-call schedule and Rockyview vision clinic, as well as the ROP screening schedule at the NICUs across the city. The ability to contribute and support subspecialty services in uveitis, oncology, inherited retinal diseases, and especially pediatric retinal surgery, would be considered an asset.

The surgeon will be expected to apply for a clinical appointment with the University of Calgary, Cumming School of Medicine, Department of Surgery and to participate in medical student, resident, and fellow teaching.

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. Deadline for application is July 1, 2023. Please submit a letter of interest, curriculum vitae and three letters of reference in PDF form to:
