



Surgical Oncologist – Melanoma/Breast Foothills Medical Centre

The Section of General Surgery, Department of Surgery, Alberta Health Services – Calgary Zone and the University of Calgary Cumming School of Medicine, invite applications for an academic surgeon in General Surgery/ Surgical Oncology with a focus on melanoma/cutaneous malignancies and breast cancer. The successful applicant will have their primary appointment in the Department of Surgery with a joint appointment in the Department of Oncology.

The successful candidate will join a 17-member Division of General Surgery at the Foothills Medical Centre, an 1100+ inpatient bed tertiary care academic hospital and the adjacent, brand-new AE Childs Cancer Centre with a comprehensive cutaneous malignancy program and dedicated multidisciplinary Breast Centre, opening in 2024. The Centre will deliver world class cancer care in a state-of-the-art facility, inclusive of research infrastructure and medical education at the UME and PGME levels.

Qualifications include an MD, certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (FRCSC), or equivalent, in General Surgery, with clinical fellowship training in Surgical Oncology with a focus on Cutaneous/Melanoma/Breast surgery, and eligibility for licensure in the Province of Alberta. Full participation in general surgery emergency call within the Section of General Surgery at the Foothills Medical Centre is expected.

The candidate will be expected to apply for a clinical academic appointment with the Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary. Preference will be given to candidates with an interest in medical education with associated training and/or proven record of accomplishment in education. Contributions to trainee supervision, mentorship and teaching will be expected, in addition to an interest in medical education curricula development and medical education leadership. The demonstration of effective teaching, supervision, and mentorship in the teaching philosophy statement from the candidate will be valued.
