I have designed a simple logo that T1D hockey players can relate to, and wear as general sportswear and/or undergarments while playing hockey.

This new logo features red cross sticks behind a red maple leaf signifying the Canadian spirit. A red ring represents center ice, which is surrounded by red stars representing athletic perseverance and strength. All are surrounded by the internationally recognized diabetes blue ring symbol. Lastly, the #NoDaysOff hashtag highlights the consistency, commitment and composure required to master one's body and live a long, healthy life while managing T1D.
