

**ADMISSION WITH ADVANCED STANDINGS**

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- Purpose** 1 Create an UME policy informing the medical student of admission with advanced standing to the University of Calgary, Cumming School of Medicine MD Program.
- Scope** 2 This policy applies to all students inquiring admission to the University of Calgary, Cumming School of Medicine MD Program with advanced standing.
- Definitions** 3 In this policy:
- a. UME means the Undergraduate Medical Education program with the University of Calgary, Cumming School of Medicine.
  - b. MD – Medical 3-year program
  - c. Approval Authority means the office or officer responsible for approving Undergraduate Medical Education policy and procedures
  - d. Implementing Authority means the office and officer responsible for implementing Undergraduate Medical Education policies and procedures.
  - e. Advanced Standing means admitting someone and proceeding to giving them credit for previous work from another program. Someone admitted with advanced standing would then be excused from certain pre-clerkship courses or clerkship rotations.

- Responsibilities** 5 **UME will ensure adherence to this policy**
- Procedures** 6 Admission with Advanced Standing to the University of Calgary, Cumming
