

**MD STUDENT PHYSICAL EXAMINATION CONDUCT**

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- Purpose 1** To provide conduct guidelines for MD students and faculty during MD program organized physical examination sessions and student organized practice sessions during both pre-clerkship and clerkship training.
- Scope 2** This policy applies to all medical students.
- Definitions 3** In this policy
- a) “Approval authority” means the office or officer responsible for approving University policy and procedures.
  - b) “Implementation authority” means the office or officer responsible for implementing University policy and procedures as well as monitoring compliance.
- Procedures 4** **Rules of Conduct:**
- During curricular/clinical time in pre-clerkship and clerkship, students and preceptors will not be used as patients. This means that students will not examine the preceptors, the preceptors will not examine the students, and students will not examine one another.
