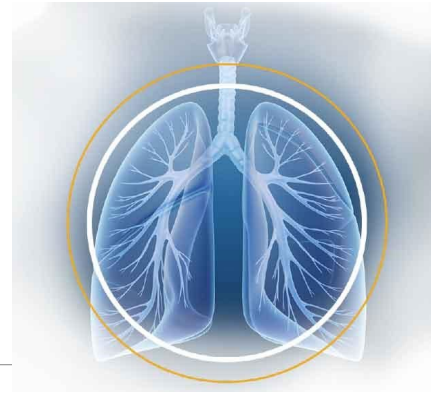

If you qualify, you will receive study-related medical care and medication at no cost. You may receive compensation for study-related time and travel.

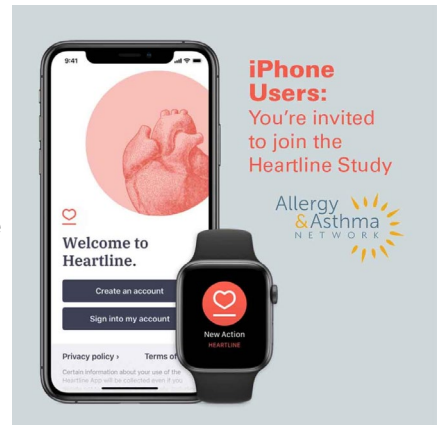
