

Rural Education Supplement and Integrated Doctor Experience (RESIDE)



What is the RESIDE Program?

The Rural Education Supplement and Integrated Doctor Experience (RESIDE) Program is designed to address challenges in physician distribution and patient access to health services in rural and remote areas of the province by supporting new-in-practice family physicians to explore living and working in rural Alberta.

Funded by the Government of Alberta Ministry of Health, RESIDE will support a set number of Alberta new-in-practise physicians to live and practice in select rural communities for a three-year period. Participants in the program will receive ongoing community and program support to help them integrate into the community as well as a financial benefit during this period.
