



North Zone: Centralized Referrals for Orthopaedics & Urology

As part of the Alberta Surgical Initiative (ASI), a new central access and intake system for managing referrals launched in the North Zone on **Monday**, **August**, **15**, **2022** for urology and orthopaedics. The program is called **Alberta Facilitated Access to Specialized Treatment (FAST)**.

What North Zone referring providers need to do as of August 15

FAST Facts:

- All non-urgent orthopaedic and urology referrals require submission to the FAST team starting Aug. 15; other specialties will be added over time.
- One toll free fax number for non-urgent urology and orthopaedics referrals: 1-833-627-7025
- When referring, you can choose:
 - Next available provider with the shortest waitlist
 - o A specific provider by name
 - o An out-of-Zone referral to a specialist in a different part of the province
- Each referral will be checked for completeness and sent to a surgeon's office within the Zone accepting FAST referrals. This roll-out is in continued development and your feedback to improve the processes is greatly appreciated.

Need to refer once FAST launches? Here are three easy steps:

- 1. Review the Referral Pathway at ahs.ca/pathways. Use it to understand what information is required with your referral.
- 2. Fax your usual referral form or letter* to the FAST office: 1-833-627-7025.
- 3. Specify if you want a next-available provider with the shortest waitlist, a named provider (e.g., Dr. Smith) or an out-of-Zone provider.
- If you need to send non-urgent orthopaedic and urology surgery referrals to other Zones, include the name of a preferred provider or clinic at this time.
- Edmonton Zone urology will continue with their current process of receiving referrals via Alberta Netcare eReferral. If you require assistance, please reach out to the FAST team. If you want to arrange eReferral training, please reach out to the eHealth Netcare Support Services team at 1-855-643-8649.

Edmonton Zone FAST Expanding to Orthopedics

As part of the Alberta Surgical Initiative, the existing Edmonton Zone Facilitated Access to Specialized Treatment (FAST) program now includes all non-urgent, adult orthopedic referrals.

Send all non-urgent orthopedic surgery referrals to 780-670-3221

FAST will continue to accept referrals sent to the existing 780-643-1235 fax number for elbow, hand and wrist referrals.

FAST facts

- All non-urgent, adult orthopedic referrals require submission to the FAST team starting Oct. 31.
- Each referral will be checked for completeness and sent to a specific surgeon or specialty clinic within the Zone accepting FAST referrals.
- This roll-out is in continued development and your feedback is greatly appreciated.
- FAST is being implemented province wide this fall, and Edmonton FAST will be part of an Alberta-wide FAST program. FAST aims to create a consistent referral experience everywhere in the province and ensure that patients see the right provider within clinically appropriate timelines.

Easy steps to refer

- Please use Referral Pathways at <u>ahs.ca/pathways</u> to understand what information is required with your referral.
- 2. Specify in your referral letter a reason for referral according to the Referral Pathway and if you are seeking:
 - Next-available provider with the shortest waitlist,
 - A named provider (e.g., Dr. Smith), clinic or site, or
 - An out-of-Zone referral to a specialist in a different part of the province.
- 3. Fax your referral to the fax numbers provided above.

New provincial referral forms will be released in fall 2022 and included in community Electronic Medical Records (EMRs).
