The Emergency Medicine Department at the [Prince County Hospital](#) in Summerside, Prince Edward Island is seeking full-time permanent Emergency Room physicians to join its team.

Our 20-bed shop has most of the accoutrements of a modern ED and offers a broad scope of practice. Here, you'll take the lead in the management of trauma, STEMI, stroke, and code blue patients in a well-organized and collegial environment. Our team has dedicated resources ready to safely manage and support our provincial Covid-19 response if and when it may be required.

The Prince County Hospital is a regional hospital that has 110-beds with a six bed ICU that provides specialty services in Internal Medicine, General Surgery, Anesthesia, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Pediatrics, ENT and Psychiatry.

REMUNERATION:

- \$175.00 per hour
- 31% (April 1, 2018) of submitted and approved shadow-billing based on the [Master Agreement](#) between the [Medical Society of PEI](#), the Government of Prince Edward Island and Health PEI. For details, please refer to the Master Agreement;
- Nights, weekends and holidays are paid at a premium (weekday and weekend nights from midnight to 8:00AM are an additional 50% of the sessional rate; weekend (and holiday) day shifts from 8:00AM to midnight are an additional 20% of the sessional rate); and
- Additional separate billing fees from third-party payers (for example Worker's Compensation and Quebec/International patients).

HOURS OF WORK:

- 15 shifts per month
- 5 days on 5 days off, a mix of morning, afternoon, evening, and overnight, 7 or 8 hours shifts

INCENTIVES:

- Qualified and licensable candidates may be eligible for a return in service grant of \$80,000 with a 4 year (7,800 hour) commitment.
- Eligible moving expense reimbursements are available.
- Opportunity to teach with the PEI Residency Training Program with faculty appointment at Dalhousie University.
- Electronic hospital patient record system (CERNER); and
- Computerized provider order entry system (CPOE).

CERTIFICATIONS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Eligibility for licensure with the [College of Physicians and Surgeons of Prince Edward Island](#);
- Eligibility for appointment to the Health PEI Medical Staff and appropriate privileging; and,
- Candidates must have FRCP(EM), CCFP (EM) or comparable emergency department experience.

Health Care Workers are required to provide proof of Covid-19 vaccination as per Health PEI's Covid-19 Immunization and Management Policy. In the event that a new hire is unable to be vaccinated as a result of a medical exemption they will be required to submit supporting documentation to Employee Health / Wellness and Safety.
