Pain Management Therapy Options

CORTISONE

Cortisone is a steroid that is injected into patients with chronic pain in a joint or cyst. It takes about two days for the cortisone to take effect and may take up to two weeks for full effect. Cortisone will reduce inflammation and may reduce present pain.

CINGALTM

CingalTM (hyaluronic acid & triamcinolone hexacetonide) is indicated for the treatment of pain in osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee in patients who have failed to respond adequately to conservative non-pharmacologic therapy and to simple analgesics (e.g., acetaminophen). CingalTM includes an ancillary steroid to provide additional short-term pain relief.

DUROLANE

DUROLANE is a single injection treatment to relieve the pain of OA in specific small and large joints. It is based upon a natural, safe and proven technology called NASHA® and is not manufactured from animal parts, lowering the risk for allergic reactions. Hyaluronic acid is a naturally occurring molecule that provides the lubrication and cushioning in a normal joint.

MONOVISC®

Monovisc® is a single dose hyaluronic acid injection treatment approved for treatment of OA and requires only one appointment per joint. Monovisc® delivers the highest total dose of hyaluronic acid of any options currently available and is not manufactured from animal parts, lowering the risk for allergic reactions.

BOTOX® FOR CHRONIC MIGRAINE

BOTOX® is injected by needle into 31 to 39 sites in 7 specific head and neck muscle areas in patients who are determined to have chronic migraines (15 or more headache days a month, each lasting 4 hours or more).

PLATELET RICH PLASMA (PRP)

A small amount of blood is drawn, placed in a centrifuge and separated into its main components. The platelets and plasma are taken from the separated blood and injected into the required area to help accelerate healing in tendons and ligaments.
