Supervised Consumption Services at Sheldon M. Chumir Health Centre Now Open



Supervised Consumption Services are

part of a range of evidence-based services that support prevention, harm reduction and treatment for Albertans living with substance use challenges.

Supervised Consumption Services

provide a safe place where people can use drugs in a monitored, hygienic environment to reduce harm from substance use while offering additional services such as addictions counselling, social work, and opioid-dependency treatment. This service aims to reduce the prevalence of:

- Overdose deaths
- Transmission of infections such as HIV and Hepatitis C
- Public substance use and discarded needles

Safeworks Harm Reduction team incorporates practitioners with diverse backgrounds that provide care, treatment, and support for people with a history of drug use in the community.

Safeworks is made up of three programs: Safeworks Outreach, Supervised Consumption Service, and Safeworks Connect. Each program strives to improve health and well-being through harm reduction services throughout Calgary and surrounding areas.

Safeworks is committed to creating a safe space that reduces stigma and discrimination and decreases the prevalence of blood borne pathogens and sexually transmitted infections in people with a history of drug use.

Safeworks' priority is to minimize risks and improve health for individuals, and promote safety in our communities.



Outreach Services



Safeworks Outreach is a team comprised of Registered Nurses, Social Workers and Outreach workers who provide comprehensive health services through a mobile outreach service as well as fixed site locations throughout the city of Calgary.

- Testing (screening) for: Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, Syphilis, HIV & Hepatitis C
- Vaccines; Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, pneumonia, flu (seasonal) & tetanus
- Rapid Antibody Testing for HIV
