


What do you need to know?

- The existing Royal College Resident ePortfolio program for tracking CBD elements ends December 2024
- University of Calgary’s Cumming School of Medicine decided to transition to LGI Education (MedSIS 3C) before the end of 2024
- **Phase 1 of the LGI Education (MedSIS 3C) implementation is targeted for release on October 2, 2024 (with three release waves, spanning October and November).**
- Phase 1 includes CBD elements only (EPA/narrative observations and competence committee meeting/decision support).
- Phase 2 is in the planning and development stage with a targeted release of July 2025. Phase 2 will include transitioning other workflows currently supported by one45 to LGI Education (MedSIS 3C).


What’s in it for Preceptors & Residents?

- Mobile-friendly interface
- EPA template remains the same
- Residents can now pre-fill assessments **OR** submit forms on behalf of Preceptor (with verbal consent)

Options for Residents:

 Send to Evaluator

Send a **“blank” form** to the Evaluator (preceptor gets an email notification with a link to form)

 Send to Evaluator

Prefill the form and send to the Evaluator (preceptor gets an email notification with link to form – can edit as needed)

 Submit as Evaluator

Complete the form **“Submit as Evaluator”** (preceptor gets an email notification) (Residents should get permission to do this!)

The system will be released in 3 program “waves”. **Go Live for Wave 1 is targeted for October 2, 2024.**

System Access for PD's and CC Chair's

- **Your User / Login ID is your existing Ucalgary or AHS (or affiliated) email address that PGME has on file.**
- A testing environment exists for Program Directors and Competence Committee Chairs. This will be provided to you in advance of your training session.

System Access for all users

- **Good news! We have received permission to utilize AHS (or affiliated) emails for users to access the system.**
- Users will receive MedSIS 3C log in instructions and more information on how to use MedSIS 3C in the coming weeks.
 - AHS users will also receive a Microsoft system-generated email that requests approval to UCalgary's Single Signon (see final slide for screen shot)

Note: All preceptors are targeted to receive access on October 2, 2024. Residents are not to access the system until their program launch date.

Phase 1 of the LGI Education (MedSIS 3C) implementation **includes CBD elements only** (EPA/narrative observations and competence committee meeting/decision support).

All other forms that exist in one45 (ITERS, daily forms, faculty evaluations, etc.) will continue to be accessed through one45 for the current academic year.

Note: Programs that are not listed do not have active CBD Residents. The remaining programs will be transitioned to MedSIS 3C in July 2025.

Using an AHS email address?

Watch for this email – it is NOT spam.

Check both your @ucalgary.ca and your AHS (or affiliated) email for welcome instructions.

If your UserID is a UCalgary email, you will receive one email from MedSIS 3C with your login information

If your UserID is an AHS email, you will receive two emails:

1st email, comes from Microsoft requesting approval to access MedSIS 3C (you must click accept).

2nd email, comes from MedSIS 3C, with your login information.
